



Admission:

- Individual ticket 13 Euro
- Concession ticket 9 Euro
- Family ticket for two adults and up to four children under the age of 14 28 Euro
- Children under the age of 6 free of charge

Those entitled to a concession ticket, on provision of proof, are: school pupils, students, trainees, federal volunteers, social year volunteers, pensioners and the unemployed, the severely disabled (from 80% disability upwards), holders of the Dresden Pass and the Culture Pass of the Euroregion Elbe/Labe.

Annual season tickets for the municipal and state museums are not valid here!

The concession ticket entitles the holder to:

- Admission to all participating museums from 6 pm to midnight,
- Travel on all means of local transport – except special means of transport – in the VVO tarif area from 2pm to 4am.

The Museum Night ticket is only valid on public transport together with an identification card.

DRESDEN'S NIGHT OF THE MUSEUMS is one of the city's highlights. Once a year more than 40 museums open their doors, offering a programme that is without equal.

For anyone interested in impressive automats, machines and robots, we recommend the Kunsthalle im Lipsiusbau, the Deutsche Hygiene-Museum, the Technische Sammlungen Dresden and the Gläserne Manufaktur:

The Kunsthalle is presenting a veritable treasure trove of mechanical objects from the Mathematisch-Physikalische Salon. The captivating science fiction drama R.U.R. – Rossums Universal Robots, dated 1920, is being put on as a radio play in the Hygiene Museum. The Technische Sammlungen is staging an ode to the world's inventiveness with its exhibition "Magic Machines". A special guest that evening is the lady robot Hellgå Tarr playing a guitar, and in the Gläserne Manufaktur, there are guided tours through the production every five minutes.

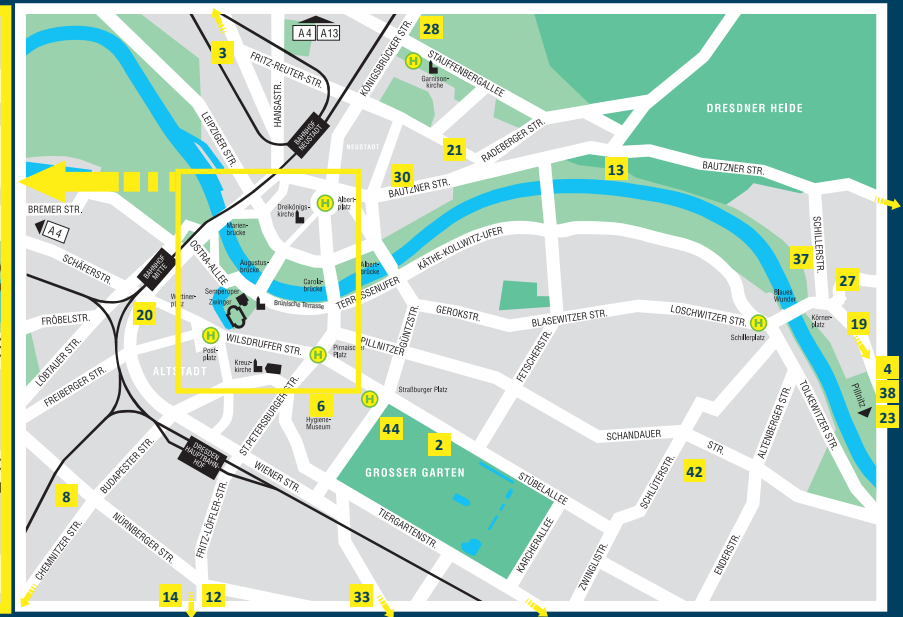
There are further musical highlights in the courtyard of the Albertinum with Kateryna Kravchenko who combines modern jazz and Ukrainian folklore; the jazz duo LeDazzo with Lena Hauptmann and Dan Baron will be playing in the Museum Garden of the Landhaus, bringing together a mixture of pop, jazz and bossa nova; and the British singer-songwriter Dan Riley will accompany guests of the Albertinum with own compositions and cover songs. Retro and electro can be heard in the Hygiene Museum, where DJane Mara will be selecting the dance music.

A special performance has been conceived by the artist duo Prinz Gholam for the Kleine Schlosshof. In the exhibition "Let's play" at the Stadtmuseum guests will be able to use a dice to decide which medieval battle scene will be re-enacted live.

In the restoration workshop of the Albertinum hidden secrets will tracked down with the help of ultra violet light. The museum workshop and the library of the Verkehrsmuseum are offering guided tours behind the scenes. The Military History Museum makes it possible to visit two depots at once! The robotron canteen will also be open for the first time with a programme by the Kunsthaus.

The museums' offers for children and families will provide special incentives: from history caching in the Stasi-Unterlagen-Archiv and the Malomat (painting machine) in the Museum Bunte Republik Neustadt, to the creative workshop in the Kupferstich-Kabinett, the stories and tales told in the Botanische Garten and the Hands-On Programme in KraftWerk Mitte.
